THE ROLE AND IMPORTANCE OF THE NEW VERSION OF THE "LAW ON EDUCATION" IN THE TRAINING OF PEDAGOGICAL PERSONNEL

Abstract: In this article, the role of the new edition of the law on education in the training of pedagogical personnel and the improvement of the quality of education and the results achieved in the field of education are scientifically analyzed.

Key words: Higher education, preschool education, training of pedagogical personnel, professional education, vocational school, decree, post-higher education.

Introduction

Every person who comes to this bright world lives with dreams and hopes, makes plans for the future, makes good intentions. Likewise, it is natural for every nation to have dreams related to peaceful coexistence, prosperous life, and sustainable development. The existence of concepts such as "American dream", "Great Britain dream", "Japanese dream", "Chinese dream" in the political dictionaries of world nations clearly confirms this. They were not formed for no reason and by chance. Each of these concepts expresses the common dreams and hopes of those peoples, the era they live in, and the future goals.

At present, we all see how fierce the competition is in the world. We can adequately respond to this fierce competition only through the widespread introduction of modern science, high technology and innovation achievements.

The developed countries of the world set themselves the task of not only increasing the production of products and bringing them to the market, but also of transitioning to an innovative economy based on deep knowledge and scientific achievements. That is, the development of one's economy by creating innovative products, adopting and introducing advanced technologies into production is becoming the main factor of development, not at the cost of spending existing medical resources.

If we pay attention to historical experiences, we can see that developed countries in the world have developed by paying attention to quality education. Muhammad ibn Ismail al-Bukhari's (810-870) statement in one of the hadiths that "there is no salvation except knowledge and you will not find it" is currently proving itself. President Shavkat Mirziyoyev has repeatedly stressed that the Republic of Uzbekistan can be reached through quality education to join the ranks of developed countries. "Another main task of the education sector is undoubtedly to educate the new generation necessary for today, educated young people who have thoroughly mastered the basics of science and their specialty".¹

On September 23, 2020, the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan adopted a new version of the Law "On Education". The Law on Education consists of 11 chapters and 75 articles and serves as the main source for establishing modern quality education in the new Republic of Uzbekistan.

More than 130 representatives of different nationalities and peoples live in the Republic of Uzbekistan. Taking this into account, in Article 5 of the Law "On Education" in the new version, "Equal rights to education are guaranteed to everyone, regardless of gender, race, nationality, language, religion, social origin, faith, personal and social status"² is set. Article 7 of the Law on Education defines the types of education, including: "pre-school education and training; general secondary and secondary special education; professional education; higher education; post-secondary education; personnel retraining and improving their qualifications; extracurricular education"³. We will try to scientifically analyze Article 7 of the new version of the Law on Education. 1) Pre-school education and training is a type of education aimed at teaching and educating children, developing them intellectually, spiritually, morally, aesthetically and physically, as well as preparing children for general secondary education. All of us are proud of the fact that our wise people made a worthy contribution to the development of world science and culture in both Renaissance periods. The role and importance of the preschool education system in the life of our society cannot be measured by anything. Specific programs for the systematic development of this direction have been adopted. The level of children's pre-school education has doubled to 80%. This task is solved not only by building modern kindergartens, but also by developing the system of family kindergartens.

2) General secondary and secondary special education training programs are aimed at mastering the necessary knowledge, skills and abilities. General secondary education includes grades 9-11. Secondary special education is carried out for 2 years on the basis of 9-year basic secondary education in academic lyceums and ensures rapid development of intellectual abilities of students, as well as deeply differentiated, vocational and personal education.

Programs for the development of 217 "Barkamol Avlod" children's schools have been implemented in the Republic of Uzbekistan for 2022-2026. is increasing. It was determined that all conditions will be created for students to spend their leisure time meaningfully and effectively. In order to develop technical and creative skills of students, modern clubs are introduced in schools, they are provided with the necessary

equipment and raw materials. As a result, it was determined that 600,000 young people will be involved in modern clubs. On the basis of the great idea that "New Uzbekistan begins at the school threshold", the work started on turning school education into a national movement in our country is moving to a new level. The head of our state emphasized that the establishment of private schools along with state schools and the level of coverage of graduates with higher education to 60-70% in 2030 will remain the main task.

3) Professional education is divided into primary professional education, secondary professional education, secondary special professional education. Primary professional education is carried out free of charge on the basis of 9th grade graduates in vocational schools on the basis of a 2-year integrated program of general education subjects and specialized subjects in the form of full-time education. Secondary professional education and primary professional education in the form of day, evening and part-time education with a duration of up to 2 years on the basis of a state order or payment - contract. Secondary special professional education in technical schools is carried out in full-time, evening and part-time forms of education with a duration of at least 2 years on the basis of a state order or payment contract.

It is appropriate to establish more than 100,000 free club activities, provided with the necessary equipment, to introduce boys and girls to the world of art, to engage in physical education and sports, and to acquire knowledge and skills in the field of computer and IT technologies, which are in demand of the time.

4) Higher education ensures the training of highly qualified personnel in undergraduate and graduate specialties. Training of highly educated personnel is carried out in higher education organizations (universities, academies, institutes, higher schools).

President Shavkat Mirziyoyev signed the decree "On approval of the concept of development of the higher education system of the Republic of Uzbekistan until 2030"⁴. The decree provided for the following, including the development of public-private partnerships in the field of higher education, increasing the level of higher education coverage from 50 percent based on the organization of state and non-state higher education institutions in the regions, creating a healthy competitive environment in the field; transferring the educational process in higher education institutions to a step-by-step credit-module system; Turning the National University of Uzbekistan and Samarkand State University into flagship higher education institutions of our country; at least 10 higher education institutions in the first 1000 places of the ranking of internationally recognized organizations (Quacquarelli Symonds World University Rankings, Times

Higher Education or Academic Ranking of World Universities), including the National University of Uzbekistan and Samarkand State University inclusion in the list of higher education institutions in 500 places; based on international experience, introduction of advanced standards of higher education, step-by-step transition to an educational system focused on theoretical knowledge in educational programs and.⁵

5) Post-higher education basic doctoral studies and independent studies, which involve in-depth study of a specialty and conducting scientific research for the purpose of preparing and defending a doctoral dissertation provides training of scientificpedagogical personnel with a scientific degree on the basis of research.

The reforms implemented in higher education under the leadership of President Shavkat Mirziyoyev are bearing their results, including a number of achievements by our scientists in the implementation of fundamental science and its results. In the main fields of natural sciences - astronomy, physics, mathematics, chemistry, biology, pharmaceuticals, geology, seismology and other areas, the results of worldwide interest have been achieved. Domestic innovative technologies in vital sectors such as wastefree and efficient processing of mineral resources of the economy, use of solar energy and other renewable energy sources, information and communication technologies, chemistry and biotechnology, genetics, ecology, production of agricultural products, pharmacology, medical diagnostics production and implementation are underway. Important results are also being achieved in social and humanitarian sciences - history, philosophy, jurisprudence, archeology, oriental studies, cultural heritage of the peoples of Uzbekistan, linguistics and literary studies, art studies and other fields. A clear example of this is the fact that "Encyclopedia of World Philosophy", which is considered one of the most important encyclopedias in the world in its field, was prepared and published in 2020, the only one in Central Asia and the first created in Uzbekistan.⁶

6) Retraining of personnel and improvement of their qualifications means that retraining of personnel ensures the acquisition of additional professional knowledge, qualifications and skills necessary for the implementation of activities in the areas corresponding to the basic specialties and profession. Improvement of professional knowledge, qualifications and skills of personnel ensures its deepening and updating, serves to increase the category, level, rank and position of personnel.

In conclusion, the analysis of the activity of scientific organizations and institutions of higher education and the effectiveness of the development of scientific infrastructure, the study of the mechanisms of scientific-research and experimentalconstructive work affecting social-economic development, the achievement of the
