



LONELINESS, FRIENDSHIP, LOVE AND LOSS” IN THE LITTLE PRINCE AS THE MAIN IDEAS

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Abstract: This thesis analyzes the thoughts and ideas presented in The Little Prince by the famous French writer Antoine de Saint-Exupery. It is about what the work is about and its essence.

The work belongs to the world famous works belonging to the genre of allegorical (philosophical) tales. This work tells about the adventures of a boy in space named Little Prince. This work is told in the language of the pilot, the only person the Little Prince met on earth. The pilot describes the character of the Little Prince in this way: his character is interpreted as a child who is very sincere, innocent like a child, who loves his planet and cherishes the little flower on his planet like the apple of his eye.

If we dwell on the main ideas put forward in the work of the little prince, the feelings of friendship, love, innocence and loyalty are put forward. The author of the work, Antoine de Saint-Exupéry, creates two characters in this work, as the main character. One of them is a pilot. The pilot is very interested in drawing at a young age, at the age of six he draws a picture of a snake that has swallowed an elephant and shows it to adults, and the adults compare it to a hat. He draws this picture several times, but adults do not understand him and ask him to stop this nonsense.

After that, the child will give up. But the child will not forget this childish drawing. After that, the child chooses piloting. After some time, the pilot's plane



lands in the desert, where the pilot meets the Little Prince. The little prince asks him to draw a picture first. The pilot shows the child a picture he drew when he was young, and the child finds out what it is. The pilot draws a lamb and a box to the child. After that, the Little Prince tells the pilot about his planet, the proud flower there, the dangerous baobab tree and who he met on which planets.

It is above all a book that consoles the loss of a loved one; There are millions of pieces of evidence to this effect. It is also a guide and survival manual in this absurd world (in the Camusian sense of the term) for those who doubt or wonder about the meaning of life, death and the relationships between individual.

The author shows us what is important and what plays the main role in our life through the work of The Little Prince. How to trust each other, to be kind, to understand that we are responsible for those we raised and taught ourselves, that we should not forget that we were all simple, sincere, innocent, little children. explains.

“You will always be my friend. You will want to laugh with me. And you will sometimes open your window, so, for that pleasure... And your friends will be properly astonished to see you laughing as you look up at the sky!”¹

It can be inferred from the extract given above that friendship continues for the whole rest of life if it is a real feeling. Friends can rely on each other even in hard times without any hesitation. This story demonstrates how to keep sacred relationships in its own way and how to treat the people around us.

In short, this work encourages us to always be sincere, innocent like children, and not to lose our identity in life. It also glorifies the feelings of trust, loyalty, and friendship. Through this work, the poet tells us that we need to see the world through the eyes of children, so that even if there are few adults, we should be far from the worries of life.
