Role-playing allows engineering students to participate in many of the activities that professional engineers participate in. Examples include product research and development, job hunting, vendor identification and evaluation, company attendance at conferences and conferences, team projects, reporting and management, etc. *For example*, role-playing magically worked in every class I tried.

We try to provide enough guidance and suggestions so that students are interested in the activity, do not have to spend a long time deciding what to say, and students of different levels can participate in the activity together. At the same time, we tried to leave room for creativity. For each group of six sheets, he simply prints one copy and cuts the sheets into individual rolled cards. Give each group a set of role cards and explain that they are all part of the same family and need to create dialogue.

You can also set specific times/scenarios.

Sunday evening, just before dinner.

Also explain that while the suggested lines can be read by students in the conversation, students can and should add their own lines.

After preparing together, have the groups appear in front of the class.
