Alexander Arkadyevich Feinberg was born on November 2, 1939 in the city of Tashkent. After graduating from school, Feinberg entered the Tashkent Technical College of Topography. After graduating from Tashkent University in 1965, he worked in the student newspaper. His father, Arkady Lvovich Feinberg, and his mother, Anastasia Aleksandrovna, moved to Tashkent from Nvosibirsk two years before Alexander was born. Despite the fact that Alexander Feinberg is originally from Russia, he spent most of his life in Tashkent. known as "Uzbek poet".

Alexander Feinberg was a member of the Writers' Union of Uzbekistan and created fifteen poetry collections. His poems such as "Smena", "Yangi Dunyo", "Yoshlik" were published in "Yangi Volga" magazine and foreign countries, as well as in different editions of USA, Canada and Israel.

During his life, Feinberg became the author of many works and his creations have seen the face of the world. For example: "Etude", "Sonia", "Poems", "Distant views", "Response", "Short net". He is the author of the poetry collection "Lgin", "Spreading Net", "Erkin Sonnets". the best artistic experiences of Russian and European poets were shown. He was engaged not only in Russian or European, but also in Eastern classical poetry traditions.

The main part of Alexander Feinberg's work is literary translation, and his translated works are still available for the present generation. r and translated his epics perfectly into the Russian language.

He did not limit himself to translations or poems, he also has famous screenplays. Among them, films were shot based on the scripts of "My brother", "Under the hot sun", "The people found in Kandahar", "Criminal and acquittals". Based on the script of Feinberg four full-length feature films and about twenty cartoons have been created. In 1999, on the occasion of the 20th anniversary of the crash and death of the "Pakhtakor" football team, Alexander Feinberg, the film "Stadium in the Sky" was shot according to the creator's script. In addition, in 1979, a song dedicated to the "Pakhtakor" team by Feinberg is created.

Feinberg married Inna Glebovna Koval in 1961. On October 14, 2009, Alexander Feinberg died in Tashkent. He was buried in the section of the Botkin cemetery in Tashkent. received

Even after the poet's death, his work continued to rise. For example, GVMalikhina's master's thesis "The structure of artistic images and thematic dominants in the lyrics of Alexander Feinberg" is devoted to the study of Feinberg's work. People's poet and in 1999, he was awarded the title of Honored Cultural Worker of Uzbekistan. Alexander Feinberg's poems have a lot of wonderful and bright humor in his poem "Strings of Rubayat" he described the Uzbek tea house with the unchanging pilaf with such pleasure and excitement that every reader's face will smile. and the mood rises. Feinberg was respected not only in Russia, but also in Uzbekistan. In Adiblar Avenue, located in Tashkent, among all Uzbek poets and artists, there is a statue of Alexander Feinberg. This is the unlimited respect of the Uzbek people for him. and respect. Many Uzbek scientists and lovers of literature are conducting studies to study his life and work.

Alexander Feinberg, an Uzbek poet and creator at heart, reflects on the spirit of the nation and peace, inter-ethnic solidarity, and hospitality in his works, as well as his childhood and youth. His rare works and translations are highly valued. The poet was awarded the title of "People's Poet of the Republic of Uzbekistan" for raising the morale of our people and strengthening solidarity with other countries. occupies a place in the heart of the reader, he just created a peak for himself. The artist and his works left an indelible mark in the hearts of readers and occupied and continue to occupy deep places.
