



METHODS TO GET STUDENTS ATTENTION TO THE LESSON

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Annotation: It is fact that attracting students attention is easy or sometimes difficult , why? Is it related to audience or speaker? It might be that students are naughty or teachers have not got enough work experience, but sometimes inexperienced teacher could get other`s attention easily. So, speaker should have his own methods to draw other`s attention to himself.

Key words: standing pose, voice tone, asking simple questions, doing activities, clothing, eye contact, using extraordinary materials.

Introduction.

“Quiet Down! This is the last time I`m asking you to take your seats! Why won`t you listen!?” These are the most of teacher`s statement for the naughty students. Yes we know that the teaching is tough and getting pupils attention is tougher! To solve these problems, there are methods to teach as you want and without any stress or rising you voice.

Sometimes getting attraction might be easy but, keeping attraction is not easy as you thought. If you are newcomer teacher, first impression is important. So, you should impress others with your attitude and different skills that others have to know you are well-educated and your teaching methods are more interesting and useful. Now, there are some ways you could use in the lesson.

1. Standing pose: try standing in front of class where you could see everyone and everything. By this way you could observe everyone.

2.Desk switch: Give students 10 or 15 seconds to change their seats to different part of place. There are two reasons why they should do this: first, changing seats help them move and get them up, second, changing their pose help them to feel themselves in different condition and that wake their brain bit.

3. Keep silence: being quiet for a while until students concentrate on you and keep silence, because they feel like something will happen and wait for you to speak.

4. Voice tone: changing your voice tone, sometimes whisper or sometimes speak loud (but it does not mean shout) that students do not feel themselves bored with same voice.

5. Hand gestures: using hand gestures help you to get audience attention like you are showing something or defining something that you are speaking about.



6. Walking around the class: going around classroom helps you to monitor entire classroom.

7. Asking questions: when you see someone sleepy or not paying attention to the lesson you could ask him/her question or demand to repeat what you have said. That will give him/her hit and after that he will fully pay attention to your every word.

8. Eye contact: during your speech you should have to avoid looking to the roof or floor, instead of this you should look directly to students and speak directly

9. Clothing: that is the one of thing that students might highly attracted by you because of your clothing. Wearing bright clothes attract audience more than wearing dark clothes, but sometimes wearing too shiny clothes might be the cause they feel eyes tired.

10. Special materials: using different kinds of materials are important. When you use different methods every time, they give their attention to the lesson differently every time. Using handmade tools or interesting materials which they use them rarely wake their interest up for them.

One more thing, everyone enjoy lesson when they participate in it, so rather than sitting on their seats every day, it would be good to compete with their friends in exercises. In addition, some children are passionate that they cannot sit quietly in the lesson, you have to give them some space to walk and think about some ideas as their willingly pose. When they realize how your methods are different from others they will willingly attend your lessons without any absent marks.

Another way that you could use them during the lesson is some tricks like when you want their attention you could clap once or twice or could use some callings like; Teacher: ‘Alright now stop!’ Students: ‘Collaborate and listen!’ Teacher: “What’s up?” Students: “ you know what’s up!”. This kind of funny way to call them

Every class has their students who always help everyone and try to quiet the class. Thank them in publicity after class gets quiet, that shows your gratitude to him or her. This thing gives them courage to continue assisting and show the class what your expectations are from them and they also always try to show themselves and keep silence.

Building relationship: when you try to be good with every students and be friendly, they know you as trustful and that will be easy to teach them as friend.
